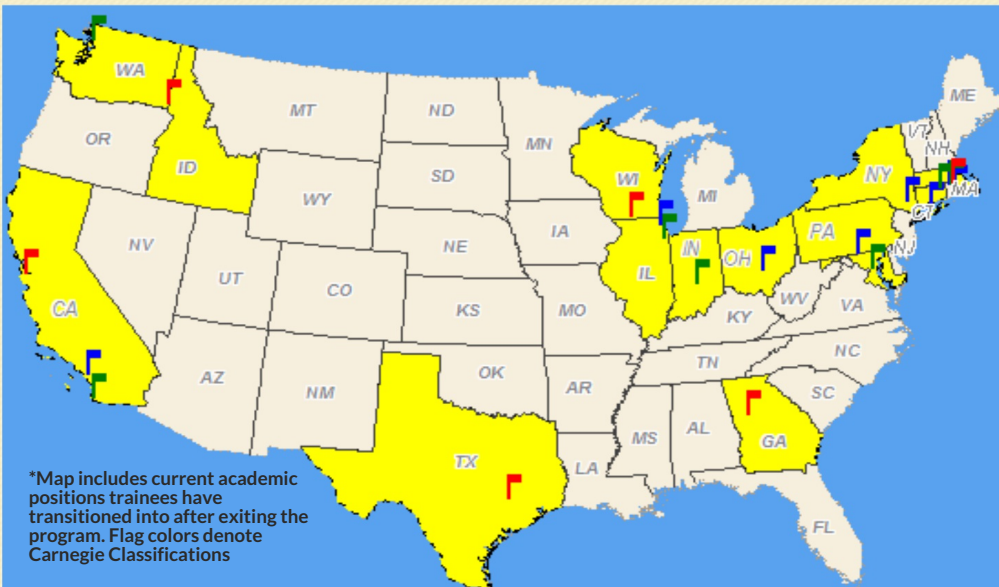

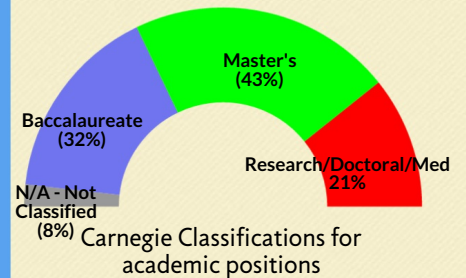
TEACRS Academic Positions
